Subject: Regarding grant of NOC to East West Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Bengaluru, run by Surya Educational Trust(R), to start a new B.Pharmacy Course.

PROPOSAL:-

In the order read and referred above in Serial No.(1) The Registrar, Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, has recommended to start new B.Pharmacy course with an admission limit of 60 seats for the academic year 2024-25, by Surya Educational Trust (R), in the name of East West Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences.

With reference to above read serial No.(2) letter, The Drugs Controller, Drugs Control Department, Bengaluru, as per the report given by The Principal, Government College of Pharmacy, in their report recommended that the East West Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences run by Surya Educational Trust (R), have all the necessary basic requirements and facilities as per rules. The said educational institution has to obtain PIC approval before the commencement of admission process as per the rules, and further recommended that No-objection certificate can be given for starting B.Pharmacy course afresh only for 60 seats from the academic year 2024-25.

With reference to the read serial No.(3), in the High Power Committee Meeting held on 20.07.2024 and 30.07.2024, it is recommended to issue No-Objection Certificate to start new B.Pharmacy Course, with an admission limit of 60 students from the academic year 2024-25 by East West Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Bengaluru, run by Surya Educational Trust (R).



As per RGUHS report, The Drugs Controller's report and scrutinizing of available documents by Government, it is decided to issue No-Objection Certificate in favour of East West Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, run by Surya Educational Trust (R), situated at Sy. No.187, Dodda Aladamara (Big Banyan Tree) Main Road, Kumbalagodu, Kengeri Hobli, Bengaluru - 560 074, with an admission limit of 60 students for new B.Pharmacy course, hence the following order.

In view of the factors outlined in the proposal, Surya Educational Trust (R), running in the name of East West Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, at Sy. No.187, Dodda Aladamara (Big Banyan Tree) Main Road, Kumbalagodu, Kengeri Hobli, Bengaluru - 560 074, has been permitted to start B.Pharmacy course afresh with an admission limit of 60 students from the academic year 2024-25 and No-objection certificate is issued subject to the following conditions.

The said Organization shall comply with the following conditions:-

1. All the necessary basic facilities and staff should be available before starting the B.Pharmacy Course.
2. The Institution shall adhere to the rules/orders in force for admission in the allotment of Government seats and to give up Government quota seats.
3. Mandatory adherence to norms prescribed by RGUHS and PCI.
4. The instructions and orders issued by the State/Central Government from time-to-time shall be followed.
5. This college will not be given any kind of grant or financial assistance/facilities by the Government of Karnataka, it is subject to a permanent non-grant condition.
6. Without prior permission of Government/Authority, the name and address of the college cannot be changed for any reason.
7. Only such course fees as may be fixed by the Government from time-to-time shall be collected from the students and seats shall be allotted to the Government in such proportion as may be fixed by the Government from time-to-time out of the seats sanctioned by the competent authority.
8. The Drugs Controller, Drugs Control Department shall make sure, the financial condition of the Institution.
9. The Violation of the above conditions imposed by the Government shall result in withdrawal of the Sanction/approval issued.
